

MILWAUKEE COUNTY CIVIL WAR DEATHS

This list is compiled from the Wisconsin Veteran's Museum, The American Civil War Research database, The U.S. Register of Enlistments in the US Army 1798-1914 and the Roster of Wisconsin Volunteers, War of Rebellion. Sectional headings reflect the headings given and used by the Wisconsin Veteran's Museum.

Lists were cross referenced and in some cases compared to 1860 census data as was the case with the Franklin and Greenfield townships. There were six towns named Franklin located in six different counties and four named Greenfield located in four different counties in Wisconsin in 1860.

Census data and regimental companies were considered to determine which veterans listed in the databases were most likely from all the Milwaukee County townships. (Milwaukee, Franklin, Greenfield, Granville, Lake, Oak Creek and Wauwatosa.)

With one exception, U.S. Navy and U.S. Marine Corps data was not helpful or able to be utilized. That data is found in "Rendezvous Reports" which only indicates when and where individuals joined however their home of record was not recorded. During the war the nearest place to join the naval service was in Chicago, IL.

The exception is Michael McCormick, USN, Medal of Honor recipient who was living in Milwaukee with his family before the war and returned to Milwaukee wounded and died here in May 1865. However because he went to Chicago to join, all records credit him to Chicago, IL. I have included him in this record.

The US Army register of enlistments documents where an individual enlisted. This list includes those soldiers who enlisted in Milwaukee. Every effort was made to document Milwaukee enlistees who died in service.

All those listed in this document enlisted in Milwaukee or in the case of the militia units had a residence listed as Milwaukee or one of the townships that made up Milwaukee County.
