MEDAL OF HONOR

Thank you for your interest in the War Memorial Center's Medal of Honor traveling exhibit. Review the information and complete the loan agreement.



The Medal of Honor is the highest US military decoration awarded by Congress to a member of the armed forces for gallantry and bravery in combat at the risk of their own life, above and beyond the call of duty. Visitors will be introduced to the symbolism and meaning behind the Medal of Honor and the Wisconsin soldiers who earned it.

Hosting information and requirements

- The exhibit contains 6 retractable banners, each measuring 24" wide x 81" tall.
- The borrower is responsible for setting up, taking down and transporting the exhibit.
- Each banner case is marked with the photo of the banner and banners must be returned to the correct case.
- The signature of the person representing themselves, or an organization, will be held responsible for any damage to the exhibit, beginning at \$200 per banner, up to the total cost of \$6,400.00.
- Banners may only be displayed indoors, in areas protected from wind, water and direct sun.
- The borrower is not required to display all the banners if there are space restrictions, but the borrower must store the banners not used in a secure space.
- The title/overview banner must be displayed with the rest of the exhibit.
- No markings, labels, adhesives or other materials may be put on the banners.
- Hosts are asked to submit an estimate of the total number of people who saw this exhibit - taking into account daily exhibit totals and for any events connected to the exhibit.
 - Note: This information counts toward our total education impact, which can help us attract the support we need to continue to provide this type of programming free of charge. Please take photos of the exhibit in your space and share them with programs@warmemorialcenter.org.

Pick up/drop off the banners

- The borrower is responsible for the pickup and drop off of the banners at the War Memorial Center, 750 N. Lincoln Memorial Dr., Milwaukee, WI 53202.
- The banners roll down, and the poles break down that fit into a traveling case. These cases fit easily into a back seat or trunk.
 - The War Memorial Center can provide a cart when you are here to load/unload.
- Email programs@warmemorialcenter.org to arrange a time along with the information on the agreement, last page.

Exhibit set-up

- Remove banner from case. Turn the metal foot on the bottom so it is perpendicular to the base.
- Remove the poles from the bottom of the base and assemble.
- The banners may be arranged in a variety of configurations - see next page.

Take-down instructions

- Push the pole up so it comes out of the hole in the base.
- Gently guide the banner so it rolls into the base and take the pole out of the top of the banner.
- Take the pole out of the hole at the bottom and break the pole down.
- Fold the metal foot in.
- Place pole in the slot at the bottom of the base.
- Put the banner back into the correct case (the banner image should match the image on the case).
